Figure 4. Literacy domains and sub-domains

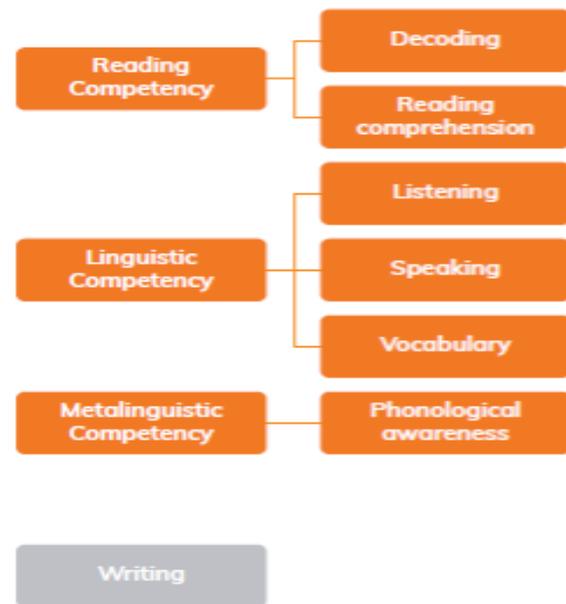


Figure 5. Numeracy domains and sub-domains

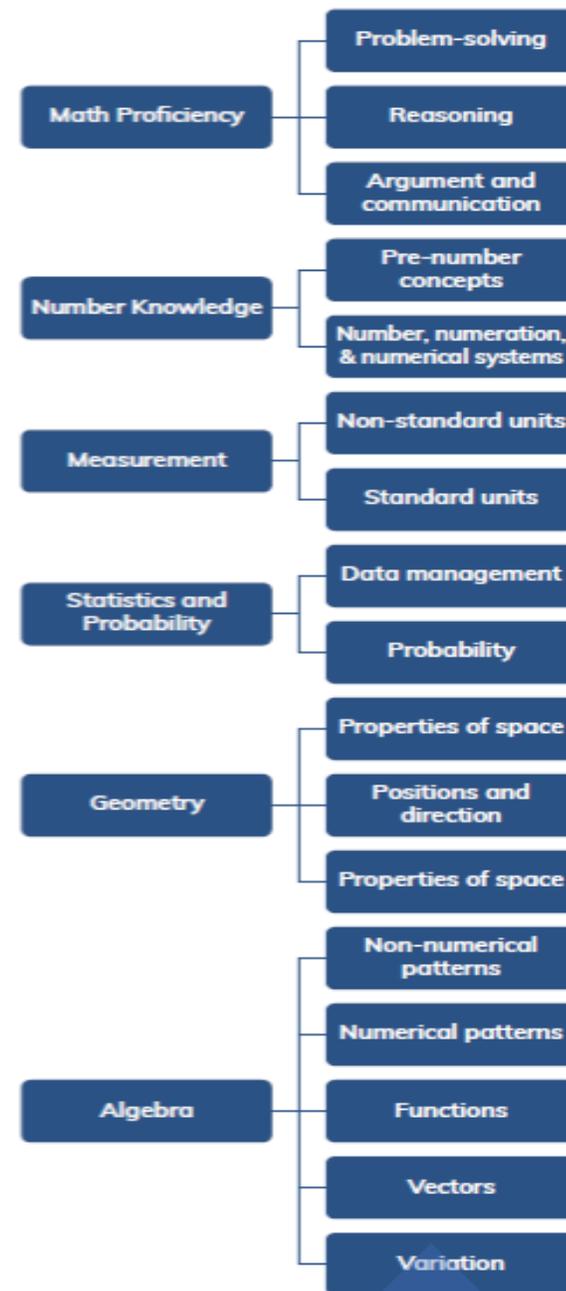


Figure 10. Domains and Sub-domains
