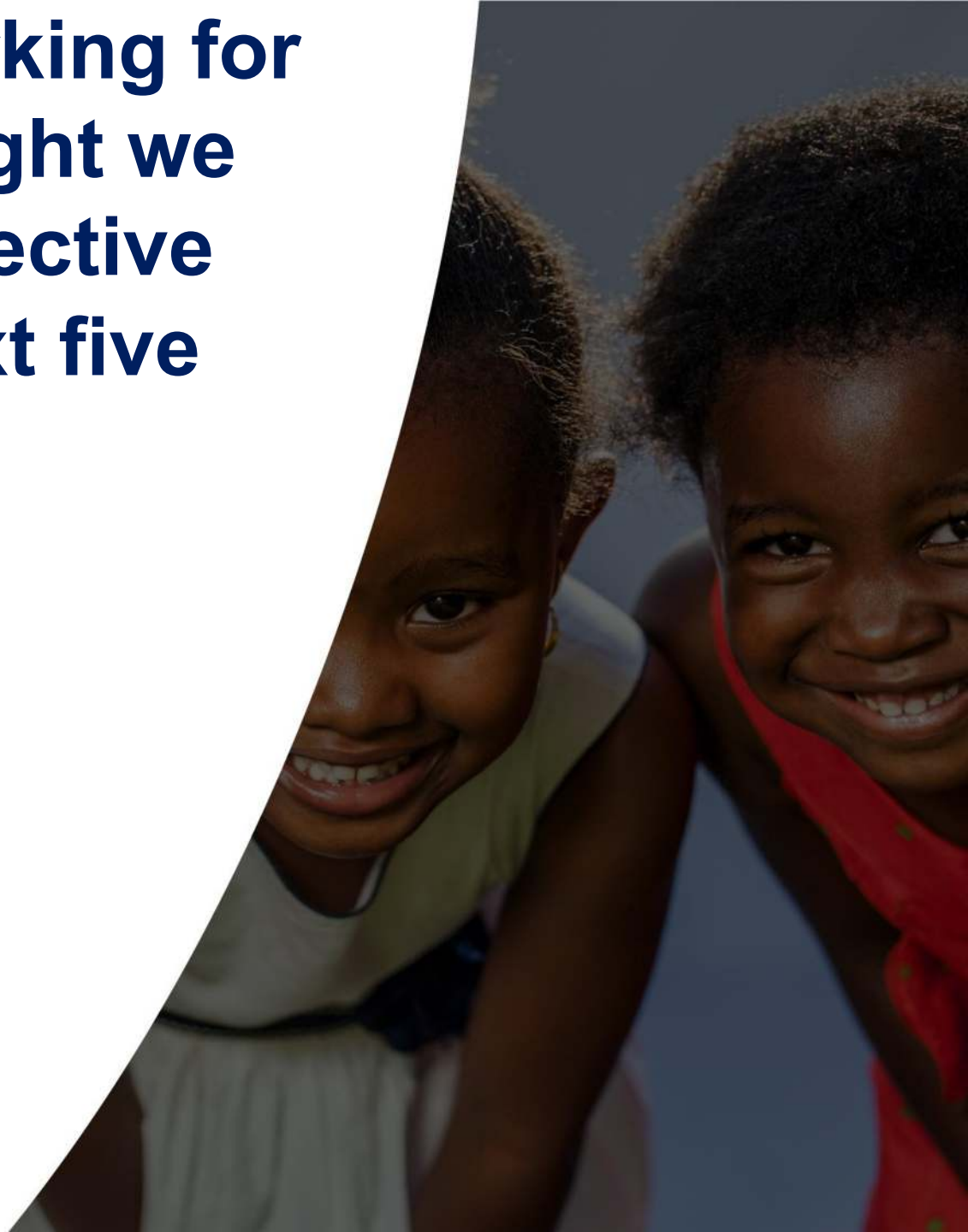

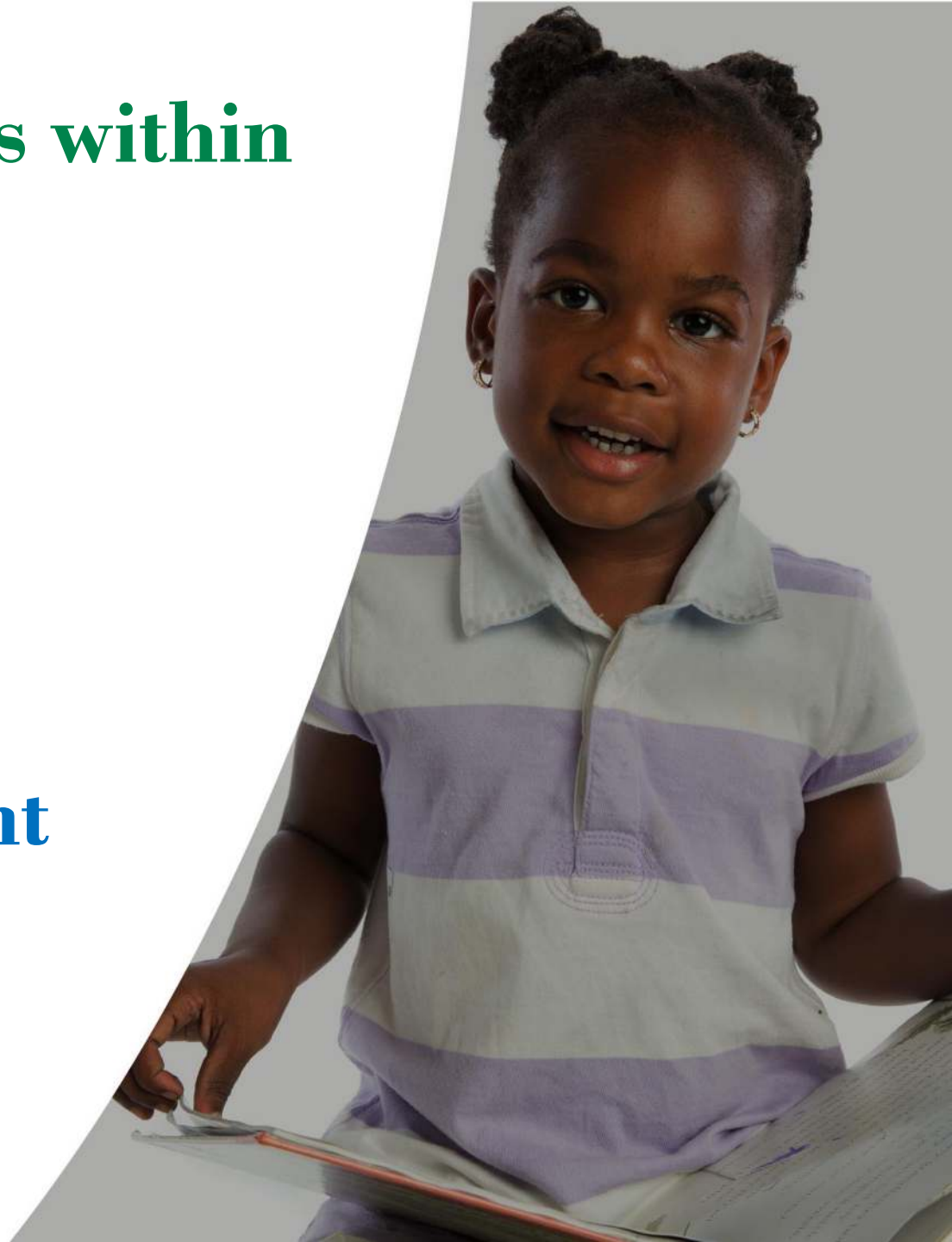

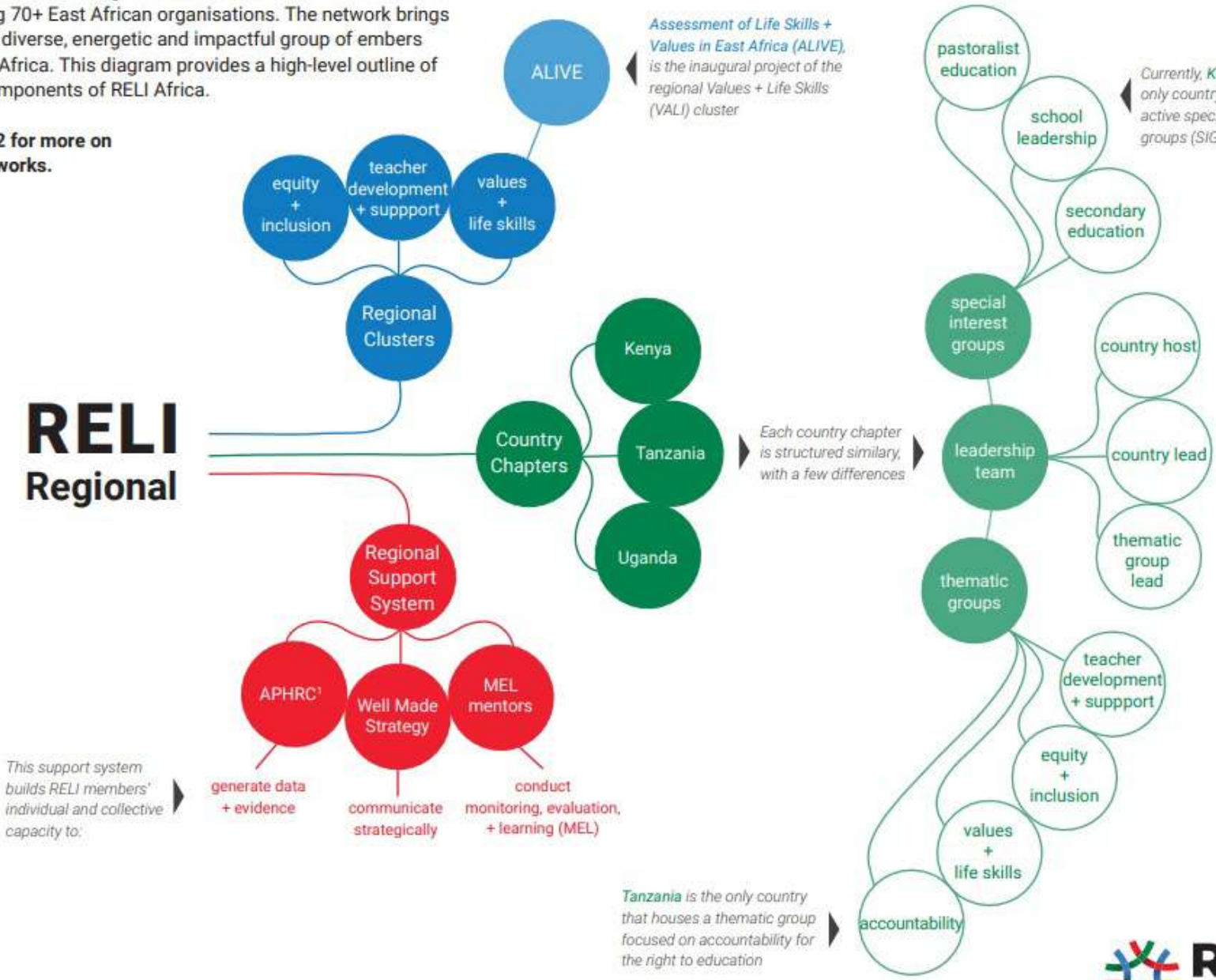
Parental Engagement
