- Build on process engagement
- Teacher role in STEM
- Develop a core course
- Assessment on competencies
- Sensitize stakeholders about importance of gender responsive education
- Value diverse voices

CONCLUSION:

- Teachers have a role in promoting STEM to disrupt gender inequality in education
- Mindset shifts require time and working with the community to raise awareness and sensitize community about the value to society as a whole in educating girls

ACTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Change in the belief and thought process of teachers is needed. This can be achieved through training, appraisal, pre-service contact, policy changes
- Curriculum overhaul to ensure gender equality
